Impact of changes to electronic gaming machine characteristics on play behaviour of recreational gamblers	2009	Schottler Consulting	An evaluation of attitudes of recreational gamblers to electronic gaming machines, is a first of its kind. The mainly attitudinal survey asks gamblers (mainly recreational) how they would respond to various changes to electronic gaming machines or the environment in which they play them and evaluates their responses.
A study of gambling in Victoria; problem gambling from a public health perspective	2009	Schottler Consulting	The findings from the survey from this study enabled a description of the epidemiology of problem gambling in Victoria. The report examines not only the distribution of gambling behaviour in the State, but focusses on health and well being issues of gamblers in an effort to understand the possible determinants of problem gambling.
Accessibility and gambling problems among gaming venue staff	2009	Southern Cross University	This study tested the link between accessibility to gambling in terms of gambling behaviour and the prevalence of problem gambling amongst Victorian gaming venue staff. This research involved an extensive literature review of Australian and international studies, as well as a survey of staff working in all Victorian hotels and clubs, and telephone interviews with survey respondents
